On **Wednesday, August 26, 2015**, the City of Sharon will open sealed bids for Toilet Room Alterations and Handicap Push Button / Automatic Door Opener at Entrance to the Community Library of Shenango Valley, 11 N. Sharpsville Ave., Sharon, PA 16146. Bids will be received up to **2:00 P.M.**, to the attention of Scott Andrejchak, City Manager, City of Sharon Municipal Building, 155 West Connelly Boulevard, Sharon, PA 16146.

It is the intent of the Owner to enter into separate contracts as follows:

Contract No. 1	General Construction.
Contract No. 2	Mechanical Construction.

Bids shall conform with Contract Documents prepared by HHSDR Architects/Engineers, 40 Shenango Ave., Sharon, PA, 16146, and 201 Century Building, 130 Seventh St., Pittsburgh, PA, 15222. Bidders may obtain same from HHSDR at their Sharon office (724) 981-8820, upon a **non-refundable deposit of \$75.00/set**.

Bids shall include a Bid Security Bond, payable to the City of Sharon, in an amount of **ten percent (10%)** of the bid, in accordance with Instructions to Bidders, as included in the Contract Documents.

Attention is called to the fact that the Project is financed, in part, by a Keystone Grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Office of Commonwealth Libraries, and the Contractor shall comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, regulations, and grant requirements.

Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Rates apply to this Project.

Contractors may not discriminate against any employee, applicant for employment, independent contractor, or any other person because of their race, creed, color, age, sex, handicap or familial status, or national origin.

The City of Sharon Bid Advertisement and Procurement efforts provide for open and free competition among available bidders, and the City takes affirmative steps to assure that small, minority and women business enterprises (MBE/WBE) are utilized when possible. If any subcontracts are to be let by successful bidders as of the project, the prime contractor must take the necessary affirmative steps to assure that small, minority and women business enterprises (MBE/WBE) are utilized when possible.
