

Full-Time Diesel Mechanic

Qualified individuals should possess the ability to perform the following:

Major and minor repair work on gas and diesel engines, as well as preventive maintenance on City vehicles (autos, light and heavy duty trucks, and small construction equipment)

Inspect and troubleshoot equipment utilizing diagnostic equipment, pull codes, and wiring diagrams; ability to operate equipment to aid in troubleshooting

- Welding and fabricating
- Physical labor under various environmental conditions
- Operate tire machine and engine analyzer
- Care and repair of City garage, shed and yard, and roll-offs
- Maintenance and/or repairs as needed to City buildings and properties
- Maintenance of required Safety Data Sheets
- Other duties as assigned

Successful candidate will possess:

- High school diploma or GED
- Minimum of five years of general automotive or municipal machinery repair experience
- Class B Drivers' License, with air brake endorsement, or ability to acquire one within one year of hire date
- Complete set of hand tools

All Public Works employees are Emergency Response Personnel and as such may be called upon to provide or assist with emergency services during a disaster, including but not limited to snow removal.

City of Sharon residency is required within six (6) months of hire date. Successful candidate must pass background check, drivers' license check, and physical exam, including drug screen
