AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHARON, COUNTY OF MERCER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 11-09 BY REDUCING THE NUMBER OF HOLIDAYS AND VACATION DAYS AVAILABLE TO FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES NOT OTHERWISE COVERED BY A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT AND RE-AFFIRMING THAT THE PROVISION OF ALL FRINGE BENEFITS OTHER THAN THOSE GOVERNED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM NEVER VEST AND ARE ALWAYS SUBJECT TO UNILATERAL CHANGE BY THE CITY WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Sharon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. (See Attached)

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void or otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of said Ordinance.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after final passage and approval by the Mayor where such approval is required.
