AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHARON, COUNTY OF MERCER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SHARON, PART IV, "TRAFFIC CODE," TITLE FOUR, "PUBLIC WAYS," CHAPTER 440, "SPECIAL USES OF PUBLIC WAYS," SECTION .01 "ONE-WAY STREETS," TO DELETE PITT STREET BETWEEN NORTH SHARPSVILLE AVE AND RIVER AVE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Sharon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:


SECTION 1. AMENDMENT: The Codified Ordinances of the City of Sharon, Part Four, "Traffic Code," Title Four, "Public Ways," Chapter 440, "Special Uses of Public Ways," Section .01, "One-Way Streets," is amended to remove therefrom Pitt Street between North Sharpsville Ave on the east and River Ave on the west.


SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void or otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of said Ordinance.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective 10 days after final passage by Council.
