AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHARON, COUNTY OF MERCER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, APPROPRIATING SPECIFIC SUMS ESTIMATED TO BE REQUIRED FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSES OF CITY GOVERNMENT, HERINAFTER SET FORTH, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 2011.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Sharon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That for the expense of the City of Sharon, County of Mercer, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for the fiscal year 2010 the sum of **\$7,557,273.00** is hereby appropriated from the revenues available for the year 2011 for the departments, bureaus and specific purposes set forth in Section 2.

SECTION 2. That in order to present the amounts appropriated to the various functions of the City in the uniform manner required by the provisions of the Third Class City Code of 1951, P.L. 662, Section 18.2 and the Act of the General Assembly of July 15, 1957 P.L. 901, Section 418 and Act No. 199 of the General Assembly enacted June 14, 1961, the amount which is appropriated is herein-before set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance is hereby classified by functions, as follows:

SECTION 3. There shall be no transfer of funds between accounts either within or between department without the prior approval of Council. Said approval shall be made by Resolution.

SECTION 4. All salaries set forth in this Ordinance shall not exceed those actual

salaries set forth in separate wage contracts between the City and employees, and their inclusion in this Ordinance shall not be construed as amending or increasing any wages not agreed to by Council for 2011.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective January 1st for the year 2011.
