AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHARON, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO ITS FY 2011 CDBG ANNUAL ACTION PLAN BUDGET DUE TO A DECREASE IN THE ALLOTMENT OF FUND FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD).

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Sharon, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION the Council of the City of Sharon, Pennsylvania hereby authorizes the proper City Officials to enter into contracts with the following Public Service Agencies for the City’s FY 2011 CDBG program year.

SECTION 2. This authorization is contingent upon approval of the City of Sharon’s 2011 Consolidated Action Plan as submitted by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

SECTION 3. RECOMMENDATION This authorization is given based on the recommendation of the City Manager, and Assistant Director of Community Development.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void or otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of said Ordinance.

SECTION 5. REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after passage by the City Council, same being formally adopted this 19 day of August, 2011.
