**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHARON,
COUNTY OF MERCER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,
ADOPTING THE LIQUID FUELS BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
2010 AS FOLLOWS:**

LIQUID FUELS BUDGET\$335,150

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Sharon and
it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Sharon hereby adopts the Liquid Fuels
budget as follows:

Liquid Fuels Budget \$335,150

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable
and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void or
otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of any of the
remaining provisions of said Ordinance.

SECTION 3. REPEALER: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any
of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same
affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective January 1,
2010, for the fiscal year 2010.
