AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHARON, COUNTY OF MERCER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SHARON, PART TEN, "STREETS UTILITIES AND PUBLIC SERVICES CODE," TITLE TWO, "STREET AND SIDEWALK AREAS," CHAPTER 1020, "EXCAVATIONS," SECTION 303.2"RESTORATION OF BITUMINOUS PAVEMENT," TO DEFINE "LANE" AS THE GREATER OF FROM THE CENTER LINE TO THE CURB OR POINT OF PRIOR PAVEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Sharon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT: THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SHARON, PART TEN, "STREETS UTILITIES AND PUBLIC SERVICES CODE," TITLE TWO, "STREET AND SIDEWALK AREAS," CHAPTER 1020, "EXCAVATIONS," SECTION 303.2(b)"RESTORATION OF BITUMINOUS PAVEMENT," IS AMENDED TO ADD THERETO THE FOLLOWING SUBPART (c)

For purposes of this Section 303.2, a "lane" is defined as the greater of the distance from the center line to the curb, or from the centerline to the point where the previous pavement ended:

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void or otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of said Ordinance.


SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
