ORDINANCE NO. 09-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHARON, COUNTY OF MERCER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE VACATING AND ABANDONING OF ALEXANDER PLACE RUNNING GENERALLY NORTH AND SOUTH AND BEGINNING AT ITS POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH FRANKLIN STREET THENCE PROCEEDING IN A NORTHERN DIRECTION TO ITS POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH MILL STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Sharon, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. VACATION: In conformity with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Sharon, and the Legislative and Administrative Codes of the City of Sharon, the City of Sharon does hereby vacate and abandon the following:

Beginning at the intersection of the west right of way line of Alexander Place with the north right of way line of Franklin Street, thence north along the west right of way line of Alexander Place to its point of intersection with the south right of way line of Mill Street; thence along the south right of way line of Mill Street to its point of intersection with the east right of way line of Alexander Place; thence south along the east right of way line of Alexander Place to its point of intersection with the north right of way line of Franklin Street; thence along the north right of way line of Franklin Street to the west right of way line of Alexander Place, the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. NOTICE: Upon final approval of this Ordinance, the City Clerk is directed to publish notice in The Herald once, and to place hand bills in conspicuous places along the line of the proposed vacation, manifesting the passage of the Ordinance and the date thereof, and further advising any person interested may appeal to the Court of Common Pleas of Mercer County, Pennsylvania within 30 days after the final passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. REFERRAL TO PLANNING COMMISSION: In conformance with the provisions of the City Charter, and the Legislative and Administrative Codes of the City of Sharon, and the Municipality's planning code, the City Clerk is directed to furnish the Planning Commission of the City of Sharon with a copy of this bill upon first reading thereof and

to request recommendations prior to the scheduled final reading.

SECTION 4. RELOCATION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES. Prior to the second reading of this Ordinance, the proper City officials shall report and certify to the Council of the City of Sharon that appropriate arrangements have been made to vacate, abandon, transfer, move, or relocate all public utilities, including the City's sanitary and storm sewage facilities located within the present right-of-way to be vacated.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void or otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of said Ordinance.

SECTION 6. REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.


SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after final passage.
