AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHARON, COUNTY OF MERCER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SHARON, PART TEN, "STREETS, UTILITIES AND PUBLIC SERVICES CODE,"; TITLE SIX, "OTHER PUBLIC SERVICES," CHAPTER 1060, "RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE AND RUBBISH COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL", SECTION .02, "ADMINISTRATION" TO AMEND SUBSECTION (e) TO REQUIRE ALL OWNERS OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY TO DIRECTLY PROVIDE FOR GARBAGE REMOVAL SERVICES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Sharon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT: The Codified Ordinances of the City of Sharon, Part Ten, "Streets, Utilities and Public Services Code,"; Title Six, "Other Public Services,"; Chapter 1060, "Residential Garbage and Rubbish Collection and Disposal", Section .02, "Administration" to amend Subsection (e)
- (e) All persons, firms, co-partnerships, associations, or corporations, that own property in the City of Sharon, that is used for residential purposes, shall be responsible to enter into, and maintain a service arrangement with the Contractor designated by the City to remove residential garbage. For purposes of this Subsection, the Grantor on any unrecorded Article of Agreement or Agreement of Sale shall be considered the owner of the property which is the subject of same
- SECTION 2: PENALTY: Any person convicted of violating the provisions of Subsection (e) shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$100 upon conviction of a first offense, and a fine of not less than \$250.00 for any subsequent conviction thereof. In addition to the payment of fines and court costs, upon conviction said person shall also be required to reimburse the City any expenses the City has incurred in the removal of any garbage and/or trash
- SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void or otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of said Ordinance.

SECTION 4. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after final passage.
