AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHARON, COUNTY OF MERCER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SHARON, PART FOUR, "TRAFFIC CODE," TITLE FOUR, "PUBLIC WAYS," CHAPTER 440, "SPECIAL USES OF PUBLIC WAYS," SECTION .02 "STOP STREETS," TO PROVIDE THAT ALL EAST BOUND AND WEST BOUND VEHICLES BE REQUIRED TO STOP AT BUDD STREET'S INTERSECTION WITH SHERMAN AVENUE .

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the City of Sharon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT: The Codified Ordinances of the City of Sharon, Part Four, "Traffic Code," Title Four, "Public Ways," Chapter 440, "Special Uses of Public Ways," Section .02, "Stop Streets," is amended to require that all westbound and eastbound traffic on Budd Street be required to stop at its intersection with Sherman Avenue.
- SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void or otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of said Ordinance.
- SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
- SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after final passage.
